# Discovery Piscine: Introduction to Python — Rules & Terms

42 Warsaw (17–21.11.2025)

Event name: Discovery Piscine: Introduction to Python.

Duration: 5 days, 17–21 November 2025 (Monday–Friday), 9:00 AM–5:00 PM each day.

Venue: 42 Warsaw campus, on-site.

Working language: English (conversational level required).

Cost: free of charge.

## 1. Purpose & format

- 1.1. The training introduces Python programming and enables participants to check their potential for learning to code and possible new career paths.
- 1.2. The event is intensive, delivered in a friendly, international environment and uses a peer-to-peer and project-based learning model.
- 1.3. The training does not include traditional instructor-led classes (no teachers, classes or workshops); learning happens through collaboration and solving practical tasks covering Python basics.
- 1.4. The Discovery Piscine is not part of 42 Warsaw's recruitment process. It is an opportunity to experience our learning model and see whether coding is for you.

#### 2. Eligibility

- 2.1. Participants must be at least 18 years old.
- 2.2. The event is on-site only.
- 2.3. No prior programming experience is required.
- 2.4. A command of English sufficient for smooth teamwork communication is required.

## 3. Applications & deadlines

- 3.1. Applications are open until 12 November 2025.
- 3.2. Submit your application via the registration form: https://5fvt1pov6b4.typeform.com/to/aEVS9EUL
- 3.3. Planned capacity: 100. Applications will be selected based on answers provided in the form. The Organizers may increase the number of places.

#### 4. Organisation & conduct

- 4.1. Participants work on practical mini-projects covering Python fundamentals, supporting one another.
- 4.2. Attendance from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM each training day is required to fully benefit from the programme. In exceptional cases, the Organizers may allow an absence on one training day.
- 4.3. Participants are required to follow the principles of professional conduct, mutual respect and safety.
- 4.4. The Organizer may introduce non-material operational changes (e.g., daily schedule) for valid reasons and will inform participants accordingly.
- 4.5. Respect & inclusivity: During the Discovery Piscine everyone addresses each other with respect. Discriminatory, aggressive or dignity-violating behaviour is not acceptable.
- 4.6. "Space Eagles" support: The educational process is supported by the Space Eagles student group, who assist both academically and—especially—organisationally during the Discovery Piscine.
- 4.7. Certificates: Participants receive a certificate of attendance if present for all 5 days of training, or a certificate of completion if they complete all projects planned within the Discovery Piscine.

#### 5. Space & facilities rules

5.1. Clusters & computer stations: Participants use the designated clusters (areas with computers for project work). Food or drinks in unsealed containers/bottles are not allowed in clusters.

- 5.2. Student kitchen: Participants may use the kitchen, including the fridge. Food must be labelled; after meals, participants must load dishes into the dishwasher and clean up after themselves.
- 5.3. Entry/exit: Access to and from the 42 Warsaw campus follows the Organizer's guidelines (e.g., badges, entry/exit log, guest policy).

## 6. Withdrawal & changes

- 6.1. Participation is free of charge; in case of withdrawal, please notify the Organizer promptly so that a wait-listed person can take your place.
- 6.2. In circumstances beyond the Organizer's control (force majeure, etc.), the event may be rescheduled or cancelled; participants will be informed through appropriate channels.
